Thoroughbred Scholarship



Do you have a Thoroughbred that once raced at Canterbury?

You could be eligible to earn a \$1,000 scholarship!

- Open to any Minnesota 4-H member actively enrolled in the Minnesota 4-H Horse Project.
- You must own or lease and have identified your Thoroughbred through the Minnesota Thoroughbred Association (MTA) application process at the MTA office by May 15th of current year. (you can submit a copy of your 4-H Identification paperwork.)
- The Thoroughbred must have had one or more starts at Canterbury Park.
- The Thoroughbred must compete at the county fair 4-H show and must earn a trip to the Minnesota State 4-H Horse Show and compete.
- Points earned at the Minnesota State 4-H Horse Show will decide the winner.
- In the event of a tie, a Minnesota bred horse gets 1 point. If still a tie, at the discretion of the Minnesota Thoroughbred Association, the scholarship will either be split or a second scholarship will be given.
- The scholarship can only be used for secondary education (college or vocational technical college)
- A 4-Her may win the scholarship more than 1 time but only 1 time per year
- MTA will hold the money until the 4-H'er declares where they will be going for college/vo-tech
